Mitzvah-thon

This year's TOR Religious School Fundraiser is joining in the *Mitzvah Revolution 5779* with a Mitzvah-thon! Each student will be looking for sponsors to pledge support for the mitzvahs they complete from January 20th thru February 10th, 2019. With a goal of 90 or more Mitzvahs for each child, we hope to both support the religious school and make a difference in our communities.

On the final day (February 10th) we will conclude our Mitzvah-thon with a school-wide Mitzvah Day. We'll count up our mitzvahs, have special prizes for the kids who went above and beyond in the number of mitzvahs completed and enjoy a celebration for all of our Religious school Mitzvah Makers.

Mitzvah-thon Timeline

January 6 - receive pledge cards and information

January 6-19 - ask friends and family for sponsorships

January 20 - turn in pledge cards and begin tracking mitzvahs

February 10 - turn in mitzvah logs; school wide Mitzvah Day celebration

February 24 - all pledge money is due

What's a Mitzvah?

It's a good deed, something you do without being asked to, something that helps someone out and makes the world a better place.

How do people sponsor me?

Similar to a jog-a-thon, people can sponsor you based on a flat rate sponsorship (a fixed amount of money) or a per-mitzvah sponsorship (a set amount for each mitzvah you perform). **Our goal is for each student to raise \$100 total and to perform 90 mitzvahs over the 21 days we are tracking.**

Prizes!!

All participating students will receive a Mitzvah-thon t-shirt, a certificate of participation and a TOR Awesome Jew Medal. Top Mitzvah Makers and top earners will win additional prizes such as gift cards, Golfland/Sunsplash passes, board/card games, toys, and more.

Mitzvah Examples

Mitzvahs are all about doing something without being asked. Think of what you can do to make things easier for someone else or to make someone's world happier. Below are examples of mitzvahs that different people might do. Remember, the challenge is to do things that you wouldn't normally do and to make a positive impact on your family or the community around you. What other mitzvahs can you think of?

Pre K - 1st Grade

feed the pets, make your bed, pick up toys, put clothes in laundry, do extra chores, be a good friend, attend Shabbat services, bring food for the food closet, donate toys and books you don't use

2nd - 4th grade

do extra chores, be a good friend, empty the dishwasher, set or clear the table, read to your younger sibling, fold laundry, clean an extra room, call your grandparents, attend Shabbat services, feed the homeless, bring food for the food closet

5th - 7th grade

clean your room, be a good friend, help a younger sibling with homework, mow the lawn, take out the trash, bring in the groceries, walk the dog, play a game with your sibling, write a kind note to a friend or family member, attend Shabbat services, feed the homeless, bring food for the food closet

Mitzvah-thon

I'm working toward my goal of _____ mitzvahs in 21 days!

This mitzvah-thon encourages the Temple Or Rishon students to put others first and find ways to help at home and in the community. In addition, we are raising money for the Temple Or Rishon religious school. Funds raised go toward supplies, books, technology and fun activities I get to participate in each Sunday morning.

Our school goal is \$6000. That is just \$100 per student.

There are two ways to pledge:

Flat Amount: You can sponsor me for a flat amount. This means if you pledge \$20, you will donate \$20 regardless of how many mitzvahs I do.

Per Mitzvah Pledge: You can sponsor me at a per-mitzvah-rate. This means if you sponsor me at \$0.50 per mitzvah, and I complete 100 mitzvahs, your donation will be \$50. In this category, you can also provide a maximum pledge amount (an amount that your donation cannot exceed, regardless of how many mitzvahs I complete).

No money is due at this time. Funds will be collected after our Mitzvah Day, February 10th, 2019.
